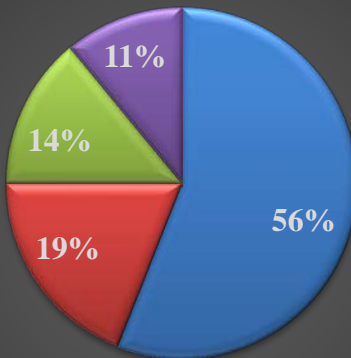

Executive Summary: In July 2015 DCHRS documented 1,466 casualties, including 202 children and 160 women. 81% of those killed were civilians. The remaining 19% belonged to one of the fighting factions. Women and children respectively made up 14% and 11% of the total number of war casualties.

Out of the male casualties, 74% were unarmed men civilians and 26% belonged to one of the fighting factions. The highest number of casualties in July, 2015 were recorded in Aleppo province (402 persons in total), Followed by Damascus and its Suburbs (299 persons in total), most of whom died due to indiscriminate shelling.
