



## A Significant Rise in the Number of Casualties in April

Barrel Bombs are killing more civilians

### Casualty Report for April 2014

**In April 2014 DCHRS documented 2852 (Two Thousand and Three Hundred) victims who were killed in different cities across Syria including 373 children and 181 women. The ratio\* of the number of adult men victims is 81% divided into 52% non-armed civilians (42% of the total victims), and 48% non-civilian victims (armed opposition and rebels) (39% of the total victims).**


The percentage of children victims of the total: 13%
