



Casualties Report for August 2013



In August 2013 DCHRS documented 3377 victims who were killed in different cities across Syria; additionally there were 13 documented victims from other nationalities.

The Ratio of the number of adult men victims is 83% divided into 56% non-armed civilians, and 27% non-civilian victims (armed opposition and rebels).

The percentage of children victims: 10%

The percentage of women victims: 7%

The percentage of the victims of chemical weapons attack in the month of August: 20%

in August 2013**

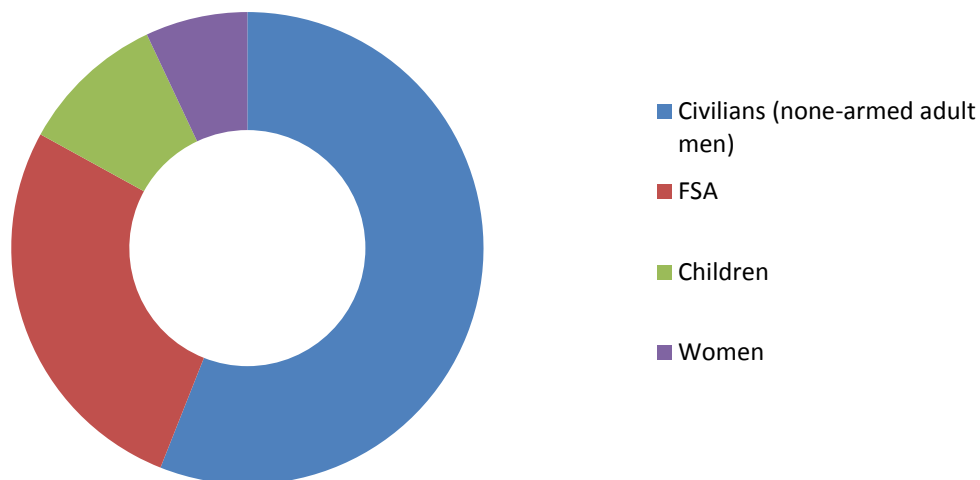
