



## **December's Fallen: Extreme Cold, Field Executions, and Barrel Bombs in Aleppo**

### **Casualties Report for December 2013**

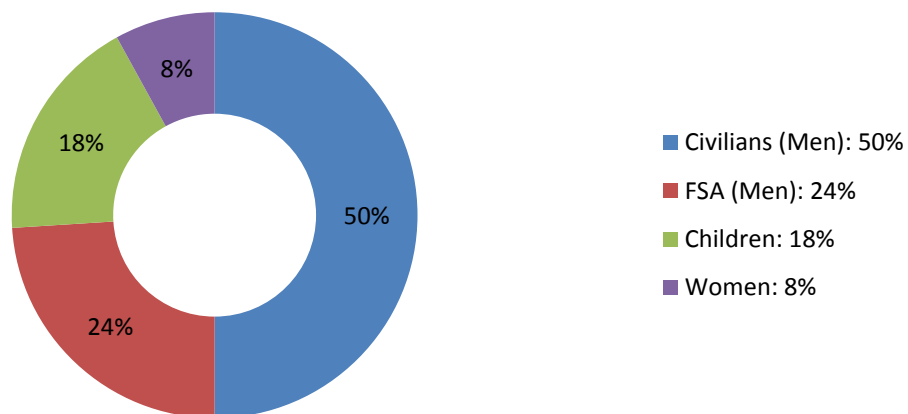
**In December 2013 DCHRS documented 3020 (Three Thousand and Twenty) victims who were killed in different cities across Syria; additionally there were 11 (Eleven) documented victims from other nationalities.**

The ratio of the number of adult men victims is 74% divided into 68% non-armed civilians (50% of the total victims), and 32% non-civilian victims (armed opposition and rebels) (26% of the total victims).

The percentage of children victims out of the total: 18%

The percentage of women victims out of the total: 8%
