Casualties Report for January 2014

In January 2014 DCHRS documented 2924 (Two Thousand and Nine Hundred and Twenty Four) victims who were killed in different cities across Syria; additionally there were 19 (Nineteen) documented victims from other nationalities.

The ratio of the number of adult men victims is 81% divided into 69% non-armed civilians (56% of the total victims), and 31% non-civilian victims (armed opposition and rebels) (25% of the total victims).

The percentage of children victims of the total: 11%

The percentage of women victims of the total: 8%

Percentage Distribution for the Syrian victims in December 2014


