



Casualties Report for July 2013



In July 2013 DCHRS documented 2585 victims who were killed in different cities across Syria; additionally there were 17 documented victims from other nationalities

The Ratio of the number of civilian victims in comparison to the total number of victims is 70%, while the number of non-civilian victims (armed opposition and rebels) is 30%

The percentage of children victims out of the total: 11%

The percentage of women victims out of the total: 10%

The percentage of men victims out of the total is roughly 79% with 49% civilian victims and 30% FSA (Armed Clashes) victims

Percentage Distrubtion for the Syrian Victims in July 2013

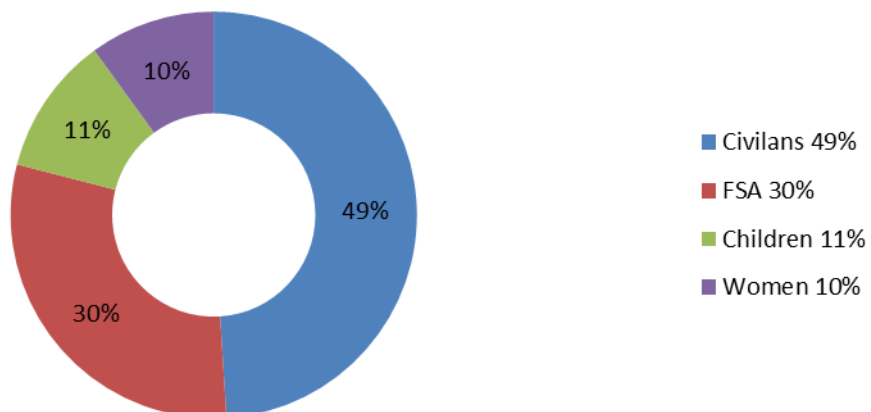
