



Siege and Indiscriminate Shelling Are Still Killing the Syrian People

Death Barrels Recorded the Highest Number of Casualties

Casualties Report for March 2014

In March 2014 DCHRS documented 2300 (Two Thousand and Three Hundred) victims who were killed in different cities across Syria; additionally there were 15 (Fifteen) documented victims from other nationalities.

The ratio* of the number of adult men victims is 84% divided into 75% non-armed civilians (63% of the total victims), and 25% non-civilian victims (armed opposition and rebels) (21% of the total victims).

The percentage of children victims of the total: 11%
The percentage of women victims of the total: 5%

Percentage Distribution for the Syrian victims in March 2014


